AGREED REPORT

Minutes: The minutes of the October meeting were approved

Election of Vice-Chair: Fr Joe Hayes SJ was elected as Vice-Chair of the board

Principal's Report: The board heard a report from the Principal on important events in the school since

its last meeting

Child Protection: There are currently no cases under Child Protection

Finance: The Chair of the Finance sub-committee gave a report from the Finance Meeting. The

committee are happy with the level of reporting and school accounts are in a good

position as we come to year end.

Ethos: The board congratulated past pupil of CCC, Fr Leonard Moloney SJ, on his recent

appointment to the post of Irish Jesuit Provincial.

Staff/School: Eleven applications for Personal Leave, one for Marriage Leave, one for

unpaid Maternity Leave and one for Parental Leave were approved.

Following the reports from selection committees the board approved three new appointments to staff. It also approved the appointment of two new Assistant

Principals and a Director of Adult Education in the school.

The Principal gave an update on Buildings and the board gave permission for the

tender process for a consultant to go ahead.

Approval was given for a 2nd Year tour to Belfast next February.

The DES report on the recent inspection in Maths/Applied Maths was circulated.

Board congratulated all in the Maths Department an excellent report.

Approval was given to a teacher to conduct research in the school.

The Principal reported three suspensions since the last board meeting.

SSE/School Plan: A report from Pinta following the staff consultation on planning was circulated. This

will be discussed at the next meeting.

Draft policies for CPD and Protected Disclosures were circulated for ratification at the

next meeting.
