Dear Parents

Firstly, I hope that you and your family are keeping well as we embark on the new academic year in Crescent. This time last year we were in the midst of huge uncertainty on whether students returning to school was even feasible due to the global pandemic. We enjoyed a very good year in Crescent last year and the only real break in face to face learning was due to the national lockdown last January. I hope that we can have a smooth return to our classrooms but I am conscious that there is still so many twists and turns in our response to Covid 19. Similar to last year, it will require staff, students and parents to work closely and in support of each other for a successful year. Here are some updates for our return to school.

Return to School Assemblies:

All procedures for students regarding Covid 19 will be brought to all students' attention at next Monday's assemblies. Students from 2nd to 6th Year should bring their school books and class materials on Monday. They will be allocated their lockers and can organise their books on Monday. Lockers:

Last year we asked students to use boxes in their classrooms to store their books and class materials. Over the summer we have moved lockers into the base classes for second and third year students. First Year lockers are the only lockers in the Junior Corridor and have been placed outside each base class. Fifth and Sixth Year student lockers have been placed around the school. The removal of the lockers has reduced any congestion points around the school and allows students to have access to their class materials in their classroom. Students can use their own lock to secure their locker if they wish.

School Canteen:

The school canteen will open on Thursday September 2nd. We are moving to a new system through our school app. New cards will be issued free of charge to all students. Parents or students can through the school app now:

- Top up your account
- Pre order food for collection

Some students may have existing monies on last year's card so if you wish us to transfer this balance to your new card, please bring your old card to your assembly next Monday. Please have your card in an envelope with your name, class, year, customer account number and balance owed on the outside of the envelope. This will be collected and processed in the next week.

School Drop-Off /Collection:

As I outlined last year school for all students begins at 8.55am. The collection times for students to avoid congestion will continue as last year:

- 3.45 pm (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday) First Year & Transition Year
- 3.50pm Second Year & Fifth Year

On Wednesday the collection times are as follows:

- 1.05pm First & Transition Year
- 1.10pm Second Year & Fifth Year
- 1.15pm Third Year & Sixth Year

I would encourage students where possible to cycle or walk to school. We have a secure bike shelter for forty bikes and we are adding a new 30 bike shelter in early September. As we will be moving to building work later in this academic year and access to the school will be limited please look at dropping your son/daughter near the school but not entering the campus. If you do need to enter the school campus please park at the back of the school and do not park in front of the school canteen or sportshall. Also please adhere to the left only turn on leaving the school to avoid unnecessary delays.

First Year Students:

I am looking forward to meeting all our incoming first year students on Monday. It is completely natural to be anxious about your first day. However, the first year induction day will be a great day to allay any fears. Crescent is a welcoming school and I am confident that all our first year students will settle in well.
